


GENERAL MUSIC TEST III – GRADES 5-6

1. **tempo** the speed of the music
- 2B. **allegro** play or sing the music fast
- 3B. **adagio** play or sing the music slowly
- 4B. **accelerando** gradually speed up
- 5B. **ritardando** gradually slow down
6. **fermata** hold the note out extra long; if there is a conductor, wait for his/her cutoff
- 7B. **moderato** play or sing at medium speed
- 8B. **dynamics** the louds and softs of the music
9. **forte** play or sing loudly
10. **piano** play or sing softly
11. **crescendo** gradually grow louder
12. **diminuendo** gradually grow softer
13. **mezzo forte** play or sing medium loud
14. **fortissimo** play or sing extra loud
15. **mezzo piano** play or sing medium soft
16. **pianissimo** play or sing extra soft
